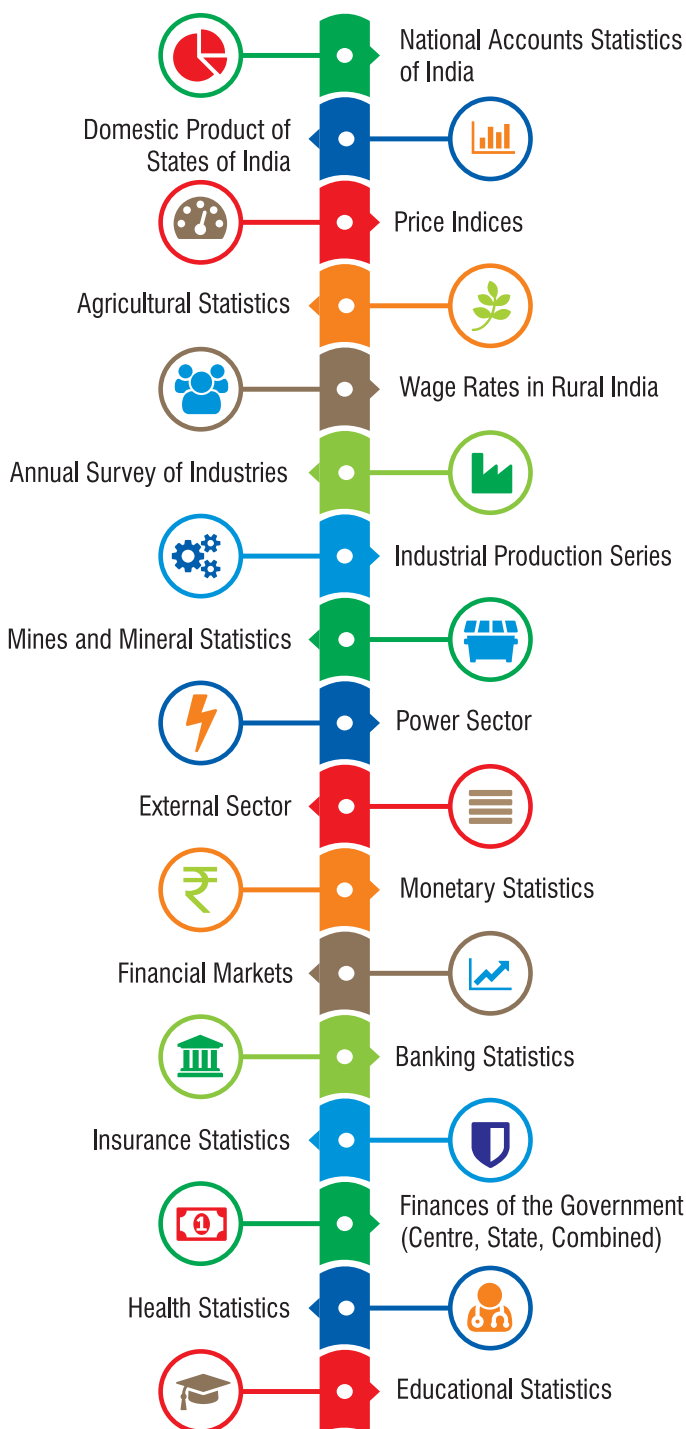

## NATIONAL ACCOUNTS STATISTICS OF INDIA

- National Income Aggregates for Base Year 2004-05 and 2011-12 at Current and Constant Prices
- Per Capita Income, Disposable Income, Price & Quantum Indices, Mid-year Population
- Consumption, Saving, Capital Formation, Capital Stock
- Income, Output and Capital Formation by Sectors and by Institutional Categories
- Public Sector and External Sector Transactions
- Sequence of Accounts
- Key Ratios and Rates, Y-o-Y Growth Rate, Deflators
- Quarterly Estimates, Annual Estimates: Advance, Provisional, other Revised Estimates



## DOMESTIC PRODUCT OF STATES OF INDIA (SDP)

- SDP (Gross and Net) at both Current and Constant Prices
- Available for Base Year 1960-61, 1970-71, 1980-81, 1993-94, 1999-2000, 2004-05, 2011-12
- SDP by Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Sector and also by Agriculture, Industry and Services Sector
- Per Capita SDP, Mid-year Population
- Sectoral Shares in Percentage
- Y-o-Y Growth Rate of GSDP and Per Capita GSDP



## PRICE INDICES

- Month-wise Index Values and Y-o-Y Growth Rates, by Commodities and their respective groups, available for
  - › Consumer Price Index (CPI): Rural, Urban and Combined at All-India and State level for Base Year 2010 and 2012
  - › CPI for Industrial Workers (CPI-IW) at Centre-wise and All-India level for Base Year 1960, 1982 and 2001
  - › CPI for Agricultural Labourers (CPI-AL) at All-India and State level for Base Year 1960-61 and 1986-87
  - › Wholesale Price Index (WPI) for Base Year 1970-71, 1980-81, 1993-94, 2004-05, 2011-12



### ***Agricultural Statistics***

- All-India and State-wise Area-Production-Yield (APY) of Foodgrains, Oilseeds, Horticulture Crops, Spices, etc.
- State-wise Land Use Statistics: Total Cropped Area, Net Area Sown, Cropping Intensity, Gross / Net Irrigated Area
- Inputs Consumed: Fertilizers, Seeds, Pesticides and Electricity
- State-wise Value of Output from Agriculture and Allied Activities
- Livestock Statistics: Production, Per Capita availability
- Per Capita availability of Foodgrains and certain other Articles of Consumption
- Rainfall Statistics: Season-wise, Subdivision-wise
- Public Distribution System: Procurement, Off-take and Stocks
- Minimum Support Prices of Principal Crops

### ***Agriculture Census***

- Number, Area and Average Size of Operational Holdings by Gender, by Social Groups, by Size Groups; and
- Characteristics of Operational Holdings by Tenancy Status, Terms of Leasing, Land Use, Irrigation Status, Sources of Irrigation and Cropping Pattern, available in a two-way classification of Social Groups by Size Groups
  - › Social Groups basically include Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Others, Institutional Holders
  - › Size Groups are: Marginal (Below 1.00 hectare), Small (1.00 < 2.00 hectares), Semi-medium (2.00 < 4.00 hectares), Medium (4.00 < 10.00 hectares), Large (10.00 hectares and above)
- Data are available quinquennially from 1970-71 for all the Ten Censuses

### ***Cost of Cultivation of Principal Crops***

- Contains state-wise Cost of Cultivation and Cost of Production of Principal Crops in terms of different cost categories classified as A1, A2, etc.
- Items of cost include Operational Costs such as material (seed, fertilizer, manure, etc.), human labour (family, attached & casual), animal and machine labour (hired & owned), irrigation charges, interest on working capital, miscellaneous, and fixed cost such as rental value, land revenue, etc., depreciation, interest on fixed capital
- Related variables such as value of Main Product and By-product (Rs/ hectare), Implicit Rate (Rs/quintal), Number of Holdings and Tehsils in sample, and Derived Yield (quintal/hectare)
- Data are available on annual basis from 1970-71



## WAGE RATES IN RURAL INDIA

- Average Daily Wage Rates, month-wise, in rupees, for various Agricultural and Non-agricultural occupations in Rural India for 20 states
  - › Agriculture Occupation: Ploughing / tilling, sowing, harvesting, winnowing, threshing, picking, horticulture, fishing (inland, coastal / deep sea), logging and wood cutting, animal husbandry, packaging (agriculture), general agricultural segment and plant protection
  - › Non-agricultural Occupation: Carpenters, blacksmiths, masons, weavers, beedi makers, bamboo/cane basket weavers, handicraft workers, plumbers, electricians, construction workers, LMV and tractor drivers, porters, loaders, and sweeping / cleaning workers
- Quarterly and Annual series (calendar year, financial year and agricultural year), derived as averages of the monthly data



## ANNUAL SURVEY OF INDUSTRIES

- Principal Characteristics of Factory Sector at All-India
  - › By Rural-Urban Breakup, Type of Organisation, Size of Employment, etc.
  - › By 2-digit, 3-digit and 4-digit Industry Groups for NIC 1970, 1987, 1998, 2004 and 2008
  - › EPWRF's Concordance Series for 2-digit and 3-digit Industry Groups
- At State Level by 2-digit and 3-digit Industry Groups and by Rural and Urban Break-up
- Data on Number of Factories, Capital, Employment, Emoluments, Total Input, Value of Output, Value Added, Depreciation, etc.



## INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION SERIES

- IIP Month-wise Index Values and Y-o-Y Growth Rates available for Base Year 1970, 1980-81, 1993-94, 2004-05, 2011-12
  - › Sectoral Indices (General, Mining, Manufacturing, Electricity)
  - › Use-based Classification (Basic/Primary Goods, Capital Goods, Intermediate, Infrastructure and Consumer Goods)
  - › Index of Eight Core Industries (Coal, Crude Oil, Natural Gas, Petroleum Refinery Products, Fertilizers, Steel, Cement, Electricity)
- Physical Output of Minerals



## MINERAL STATISTICS

---

Provides following data for over 60 minerals

- Reserves and Resources
- Mining Leases, Status of Expiry and Prospective Licenses
- Index of Mineral Production
- Consumption, Production and Closing Stock
- Exports and Imports
  - › by Ores and Minerals
  - › by Principal Countries
- Data available state-wise and back from 1956 depending upon availability



## STATISTICS OF MINES

---

Contains 2 sub-modules, Coal Mines and Non-Coal Mines, covering aspects such as

- Number of Mines and Output
- Average Daily Employment by Category of Workers and by Gender
- Productivity in Coal Mines
- Average Weekly Wages by Place of Work (Above Ground, Below Ground, Open Cast)
- Index of Labour Earnings
- Gassiness in Below Ground Coal Mines
- Consumption of Explosives
- Usage of Machineries by Place of Work
- Accidents and Casualties by Place of Work and by Causes
- Exports and Imports of Coal, Coke and Lignite
- Data available state-wise and back from 1965 depending upon availability



## POWER SECTOR

---

Covers wide-ranging data for States and at All-India level

- Installed Capacity: Utilities and Captive Power Plants
- Gross Generation by SEBs, Govt. Undertakings / Central Sector, Municipalities and Private Licenses
- Length of Transmission and Distribution Lines, Transformers and their Capacity
- Energy Sales to Ultimate Consumers, Energy Sold to - Domestic, Industrial, Agricultural, PWW, Public Lighting and Traction Purposes
- Per Capita Power Consumption, Town & Village Electrification, Pumps & Tube-wells Energised
- Power Leakages



## EXTERNAL SECTOR

- India's Foreign Trade: Exports, Imports, Trade Balance by Product Group (HS Code Classification)
- Balance of Payments: Details of Current and Capital Account
- External Debt: Multilateral, Bilateral, Trade Credit, Short-term Debt, Debt Stock to GDP Ratio, Debt Service Ratio
- International Investment Position: External Assets and Liabilities by Direct Investment, Portfolio Investment, etc.
- Foreign Exchange Reserves and its Components
- Indices of REER and NEER of the Indian Rupee



## MONETARY STATISTICS

- Money Stock & Components with data frequency of monthly, quarterly and annual
  - › Money Stock – M1, M2, M3, M4, M0
  - › Components of Money Supply – Currency with the Public, Demand & Time Deposits with Banks, Post Office Savings, Bankers' Deposits with RBI
  - › Sources of Change in Money Supply (M3) – Bank Credit to Government and Commercial Sector, Net Foreign Exchange Assets of Banking Sector, Government's Currency Liabilities to Public, Net Monetary Liabilities
- Structure of Interest Rates (Frequency: month, quarter, annual, effective dates; Rate: Upper, lower, range, weighted average, as the case may be)
  - › Monetary Policy Rates and Ratios
  - › Rates on Saving Instruments, Lending Rates, Redemption Yield, Historical Rates (discontinued after a while)
- Payment and Settlement System (annual series)
- Currency Management: Notes and Coins Issued and Counterfeit Notes Detected (annual series)



## FINANCIAL MARKETS

- Comprises Fixed Income Market, Money Market and Forex Market
- Fixed Income Market: G-Sec Market: Primary and Secondary Issues
- Money Market: Liquidity availed from RBI, RBI's Repo / Reverse Repo Auction under LAF, Call Market, Notice Money Market, Term Money Market, CBLO, CD, CP, etc.
- Forex Market: Exchange Rate, Turnover, RBI Intervention



## BANKING STATISTICS

---

- Comprises annual data of Basic Statistical Returns System on Scheduled Commercial Banks' Deposit, Credit, C-D Ratio, Number of Offices and Number of Employees at All-India, State and District level
  - › By Population Group (Rural, Semi-urban, Urban, Metropolitan)
  - › By Bank Group (Public Sector, Private Sector, Regional Rural Banks and Foreign Banks)
  - › Credit by Occupation (Agriculture, Industry, Trade, Transport Operators, Personal Loans, etc.)
  - › Credit by Type, Interest Range, Size, Organisation / Institutional Category, etc.
- Deployment of Gross Bank Credit (Monthly)
  - › By Major Sectors
  - › By Industry
  - › Priority Sector Advances
- Liabilities and Assets, Earnings and Expenses
  - › Disaggregate Level by Bank Group
- Classification of Loan Assets, Non-performing Assets (NPAs) and Recovery of NPAs



## INSURANCE STATISTICS

---

Contains data of Life and Non-life Insurance Business

- Life Insurance Data at All-India and State level
- Life Insurance: Number of Offices, Agents and Policies, Premium, Individual Death Claims, Solvency Ratios
- Non-life Insurance (Motor, Health, Fire, Marine and Other Miscellaneous Insurance): Number of Policies, Premium, Net Retention, Asset Under Management, Solvency Ratios, Incurred Claims Ratio
- Company-wise details of Policyholder Account, Shareholder Account, Balance Sheet
- Cross Country Indicators: Density and Penetration of Life and Non-life Insurance



## FINANCES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

---

- Government Finances at a Glance, Surplus/Deficit
- Revenue Receipts (Gross Tax Revenue, States' Share, Non-tax Revenue, Dividends and Profits, etc.)
- Capital Receipts (Market Borrowing, External Assistance, Recovery of Loans, etc.)
- Revenue and Capital Expenditure (Economic Services, Social Services, General Services, Expenditure of UTs Loans and Advances, etc.)
- Liabilities and Assets of Central Government (Public Debt, etc.)



## FINANCES OF STATE GOVERNMENTS

- State Government Finances at a Glance
- State Governments' Aggregate Receipts and Expenditures, Revenue and Capital Receipts, Revenue and Capital Expenditure, Tax and Non-tax Revenue, Developmental and Non-developmental Expenditure
- Outstanding Liabilities: Internal Debt, Borrowings from Banks and FIs, Loans and Advances from Centre, etc.
- Budgetary Surplus/Deficit Position



## COMBINED GOVERNMENT FINANCES

- Combined Government Finances at a Glance
- Budgetary Transactions of Centre, States and UTs
- Combined Receipts and Expenditures
  - › Revenue Receipts: Tax Revenue (Direct and Indirect Taxes) and Non-tax Revenue
  - › Capital Receipts: Market Loans, External Debt, etc.
  - › Combined Expenditure: Developmental, Non-developmental, Loans and Advances, etc.
- Outstanding Liabilities
- Budgetary Surplus / Deficit Position



## HEALTH STATISTICS

Contains data for States and at All-India level

- Demographic Indicators: Population, Birth Rate, Death Rate, Fertility Rate
- Health Status: Communicable and Non-communicable Diseases, Reproductive and Child Healthcare Indicators
- Infrastructure: Rural and Urban Govt. Hospitals, AYUSH and Allopathic Hospitals and Dispensaries, Sub-centres, PHCs and CHCs, Infrastructural facilities available at Sub-centres, PHCs and CHCs, Blood Banks, Medical Colleges
- Human Resources: Number of Doctors, Dental Surgeons, Nurses, Pharmacists, Health Assistants, Health Workers, Specialists at CHCs, Lab Technicians
- Education Facilities: Under-graduate and Post-graduate Colleges of AYUSH, PG Diploma and MD Courses
- Public Expenditure in Health Sector

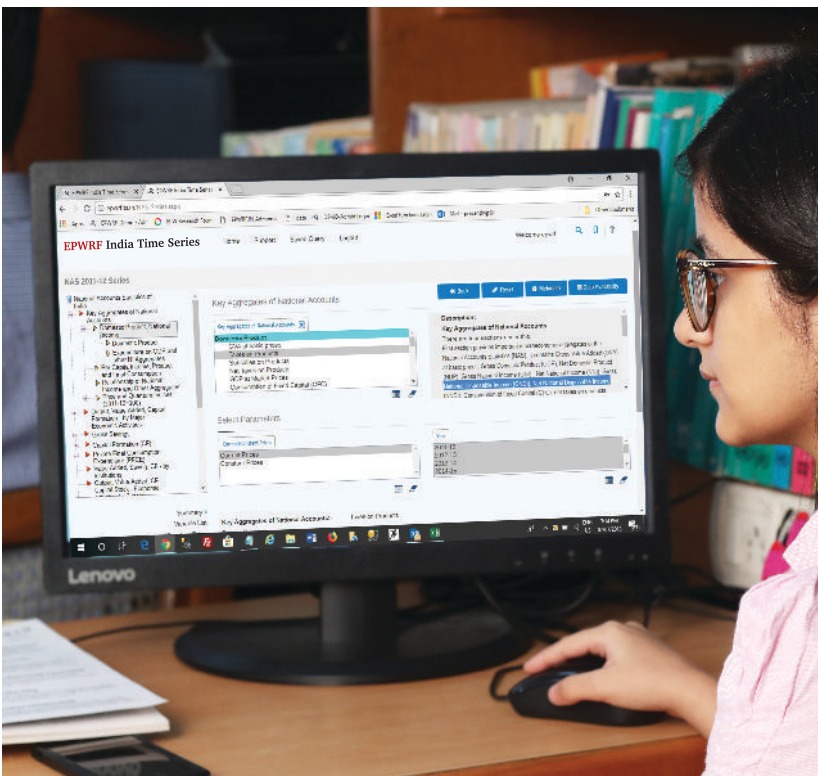
